In the Northern Valley High School District, Advanced Placement or Honors credit will not be awarded for summer school. Courses taken for new credit will not be computed in class rank, or toward grade point averages.

Tuition for New or Review courses apply to all students except Northern Valley residents in grades 9-12 as of September 2009.

- A \$25 Administrative fee must be paid by all students upon enrollment.
- Tuition fees must be paid in advance.
- Tuition is payable by check or money order to:  
"Northern Valley Regional High School District."
- There will be no refunds after the first day of classes.
- Proof of residence will be requested at registration.

\* Review courses are designed for students who have previously taken the course and have failed. Students may not enroll in a Review class without having taken and failed the course. Verification from a guidance counselor will be a requirement.

\*\*Any student who attains more than 3 absences will receive an Administrative Withdrawal Failure.



# SUMMER SCHOOL GUIDELINES

## 1 ATTENDANCE

Summer school courses meet for thirty (30) days. Any student who has attended a class fewer than twenty-seven days will not be eligible to take the final examination. This requirement is necessary in order to uphold accreditation standards. The policy will be enforced regardless of the reason. A student who is absent or late for any combination of three absences will be withdrawn from summer school. No tuition will be refunded. Two tardies is equal to one absence. Students arriving fifteen minutes late or more are absent for the day.

## 2 REVIEW FOR FAILED WORK

Work completed during summer school may assure a student is being scheduled with his regular class the next year.

## 3 MAKE-UP CREDIT

Review courses make up for deficiencies and assure a sufficient number of credit units for graduation.

## 4 ADVANCED WORK

New courses meet for four hours.

## 5 EXAMINATIONS AND REPORT CARDS

Report cards for credit courses will be issued every ten (10) days. Final examination for credit courses will be administered the last day of summer school. Students are asked to bring in a stamped envelope for each course they are taking if they wish to have the report card mailed home upon the completion of summer school.

## 6 AMOUNT OF WORK

For credit courses, the amount of work to be completed is the same as required during the regular school year.



## SUMMER SCHOOL CODE OF CONDUCT

- A. Tardiness as a result of bus schedules, trains, flat tires, etc. will not be excused.
- B. Books and supplies must be handled carefully.
- C. Students must abide by the same rules of conduct that apply within Northern Valley High Schools at other times during the year.
- D. Attire may be informal and comfortable, but should be in keeping with prevailing school standards.
- E. No smoking is permitted on school grounds or anywhere in any part of the school building.
- F. Cars are permitted when driven carefully and should be parked only in the student lot, north of the building.
- G. Students who do not abide by the rules will be dropped without a refund of tuition.

Student drop-off and pick-up:  
Students may be dropped off in front of the school at the beginning of class.  
Cars should pull up as far as possible to allow for others to clear the driveway.
